



Antelope Island's Cowboy Legends

This Document contains the Regular & Food Vendor Information & Application for the
2018 Antelope Island's Cowboy Legends show
Being held at the historic Fielding Garr Ranch on Antelope Island State Park, Utah
Memorial Weekend May 25-28, 2018.

This is a great opportunity for Regular and Food Vendors as we have had over 10,000+ in attendance during this event and we anticipate more as this event does get more popular every year!

We are looking for Vendors with a Western, Cowboy, and Cowgirl, Country or Historic theme to enhance the show. Crafts, art, clothing, hats, boots, tack, leatherwork, quilting, silversmiths, and Food Vendors with an enthusiasm and talent to provide the best tasting food for the event.

The vendor fee for the entire event is \$150 for a 10x10 or \$200.00 for 10x20. This includes 2 vehicle passes per booth for the entire weekend. Vendors may also camp in the field west of the vendor area. (Included with your vendor fee!) Vendors camping may also bring their own horses and enjoy riding on the Island each day. (You Must provide your own corral panels, water buckets, and certified weed free hay.) Keep in mind this is an outdoor show with unknown weather conditions. You will need to provide your own shelter and power. Restrooms are provided on site.

Set up time will be Friday May 25th from 7:00am – 4:00 pm. You **cannot** operate your booth on Friday. Booths can be operated Saturday, Sunday, & Monday. The events start at 10:00 am so we ask that booths be open and ready by 9:00 am each of operating days, with closing time around 8pm.

All Vendors Check List: "This applies to all Vendors"

- Checks made out to "Friends of Antelope Island"
- Vendors are responsible to pay all appropriate Federal and State & Local taxes on revenue from this event. "Antelope Island's Cowboy Legends"
- You must remain open until 5:00 pm on Monday.

Food Vendors Check List: " This only applies to Food Vendors"

- You must obtain a Temporary Food Establishment Permit. Individuals seeking a permit to sell food at a one-time event may obtain a temporary permit from Davis County Environmental Health Services.
- A copy of the Menu must be given to Antelope Island's Cowboy Legends committee 3 weeks prior to event for approval.
- Menu prices cannot be adjusted during the event unless agreed upon by both The Vendor and the Committee.
- Food Vendors **cannot** sell food after 5pm on Friday & Saturday.

We also have kid's activities in the vendor area to bring traffic into the area. All vendors are asked to donate or lend help with the kid's activities; we do need a lot of volunteers to help. I.E. Coloring pages, quilting or leather scraps, Stamps, paints, ropes, color crayons, etc. Let us know if you have ideas you'd like to do for the kid's activities! The kid's get a passport when they arrive for which they come to the vendor area to try different activities. They get a stamp for each one and can turn in the passport with 6 or more stamps for a prize! This is very popular and brings a lot of people into the vendor area!
